

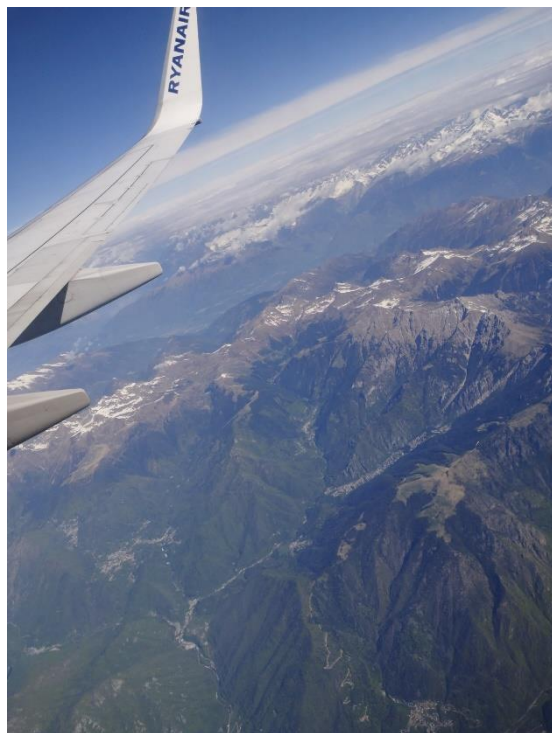
Our trip to Italy
