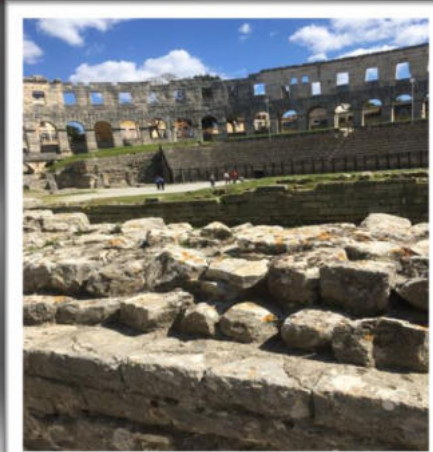
We also had some free time, during which we explored the old town of Rovinj. We had pizza, did some shopping, and took photos.
