Universal design for learning

- Universal Design for Learning (UDL) gives all students an equal opportunity to succeed
- This approach to teaching and learning offers flexibility in the ways students access material and show what they know
- UDL also looks for different ways to keep students motivated



The 3 main principles of UDL is:


1. Engagement – where we look for ways to motivate learners and sustain their interest
 - a. Let students make choices
 - b. Give assignments that feel relevant
 - c. Create opportunities for students to get up and move around
2. Representation – offer information in more than one format
 - a. Audio
 - b. Video
 - c. Hands on
3. Action and expression – get learners more than one way to interact with the material and to show what they know
 - a. Paper and pencil
 - b. Oral report
 - c. Video
 - d. Group project
